The California Immunization Registry (CAIR) is in the process of being updated to a **bigger, better, and faster** immunization information system: CAIR2. It's time for you to get ready. Start by reviewing the "[Get Ready to Move to CAIR2 Checklist](#)" and visiting the [CAIR2 webpage](#) to find out more about CAIR2.

To help prepare for transitioning to CAIR2, [training](#) will be required for [Power and Regular CAIR Users](#) before your region's launch date. The training will orient you to the new software so that you are ready to begin using it when your region switches over. You will receive an email with registration information on October 3. Only Power and Regular users who have actively used CAIR within the last 6 months (and started before September 30) will be able to register for training before the switchover to CAIR2. Training will be available for inactive and new users after the launch.

Training is not required for [Read-only users](#). However, [instructional videos and a written guide](#) will be available by October.
