Updated Menu for Patient Search

You may have already noticed that the left side menu of CAIR2 has been simplified. Three items under **Patients** have been combined. **Manage Patient** and **Add New Patient** were similar to **Patient Search**, so all three were combined. The single menu option still has all of the same functionality of the three.
