Agenda Item	Discussion	Results/Actions
1) Review of how to find chat box, which will be used in today’s call 2) Approval of minutes from last meeting (July 26)	To vote regarding minutes, use the chat box, send messages to “All Panelists”  Hit *1 if you have a question. Any modifications to minutes? None recommended.	Minutes were approved and will be posted on Cairweb.org.
3) Prioritization of Improvements/enhancements	Review of survey monkey results –14 surveys have been completed so far. Will remain open until 8/27 to potentially collect more responses.  See slides for reviewed responses:  Q1 Update inventory accordingly when vaccine is shared in the EHR – 50% thought it would be a significant benefit for the user and 57% thought it would improve data quality.	

	<p>71% that there would be a clinical impact on patient care and improve data quality if there was consistency on reading and document records from other countries. Even though this doesn't currently exist, it's best to put combination vaccines in as separate vaccines. Vaccines from other countries are not likely to be added soon to CAIR2 because there are so many. If you are adding vaccines from other countries, please do so as single antigens.</p> <p>Adding a sibling/spouse button that would enable us to carry much of the same information over to a new client registration so as not to have to reenter the same information again would also be a big time saver. We will be taking this back to the steering committee and let them know that the User Group thinks this would improve data quality and clinical care.</p> <p>We will also be working on reports from bidirectional exchanges because the majority of respondents want reports to work with bi-directional exchange.</p> <p>Can CAIR2 accept an accelerated schedule? Greater than 71% thought it would be a significant benefit.</p> <p>79% agreed that we need to require VFC providers to use CAIR2 – this will have a benefit regarding patient care, improve data quality, and improve the user experience.</p> <p>Next Steps after survey – analyze responses and share results to CAIR2 Steering Committee. Feedback will be combined from the two groups for consensus. That will then lead to software testing and then future release dates.</p>	
<p>4) Managing Patients (Demo) (Cecilia)</p>	<p>This was briefly discussed at last call. Now wanting a final vote and count.</p> <p>Presentation of what the screens currently look like within Training – Demo of screens for Patient Search – clicking on the patient takes you to Update Patient screen. Last month, it was concluded that people would be okay with combining Patient Search, Manage Patient and Add New Patient.</p> <p>Conducted Polling question:</p>	<p>Result of Polling Question: Option 1 -- Combine all three and go to <i>Update Patient</i> Screen. 8 out of 23 voted in that way.</p> <p>Next steps – take it back to Steering Committee</p>

	<p>Option 1 – combine all three options into one but have it go to Update Patient Screen.</p> <p>Option 2 – Combine all three options into one but have it go to the Immunization History screen.</p> <p>Option 3 – Leave as is with the three different options separately – manage patient, add new patient and patient search.</p>	
5) Reminder Recall Enhancement Discussion/Polling Question	<p>Additional Polling question regarding what will work best when conducting reminder/recall? 1. Phone Number? 2. Email address? 3. Both?</p>	<p>Majority of respondents chose both phone and email addresses.</p> <p>Comment that the address might be the most comprehensive way to reach people. Address will stay as part of the record and email and phone can be added as supplemental information.</p>
6) Questions	<p>Comment re: foreign country immunizations – is it possible to put under comments that it is an international vaccine and a combination vaccine? Will look into that, best to enter it as IPV, DTaP and Pentavelente in the comments section under IZ History when doing data entry.</p> <p>Some clients only have one letter in last name and CAIR2 doesn't accept that.</p> <p>Is it possible to increase the amount of time before CAIR2 locks you out? When putting IZs into history, it seems to be locking people out in less than 5 minutes. Can a screen be added to say something like "you will be logged out in X time unless you press here)</p>	<p>CDPH can explore where it might be best to add the name of the vaccine from the other country – might be in Notes or Comments section.</p> <p>That's true and CDPH is working on determining if names with less than 3 letters can be accepted.</p> <p>Please document this problem and send it to the Help Desk to take a look and see. CDPH can also discuss with the vendor the possibility of a warning message that says you will be logged out shortly.</p>
