Agenda Item	Discussion	Results/Actions
1) Welcome Back!!	No suggested changes.	Minutes were approved and will be posted on Cairweb.org.
2) 2.5.1 Release	Testing is almost complete – see slides for specific items CDPH and technical team are working on fixes for certain issues. UAT was down for a bit so testing was put on hold but UAT is now up so testing has resumed. Release 2.5.1 should be out in month of June. Issues being addressed include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 7796 is a data exchange item is a fix for inventory decrementing</li> <li>• 7738 is also a data exchange item where fields weren’t changing to “Yes” properly but now they are</li> <li>• 7764: People liked the design of the Yellow Card that was previously sent out and these pop-up disclaimers will go along with that.</li> </ul>	

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 6800 (a different # is listed on slides but 6060 is accurate) – the post exposure rabies vaccine is now being allowed</li> <li>• 7353:For vaccines being administered and being entered historically, the 14 day duplicates will not be accepted (except rabies should be an exception)</li> </ul>
<p>3) User Group Feedback</p> <p>For combination vaccines enter into one antigen and then click Add Details to choose the trade name</p>	<p><b>Reminder/Recall Report</b>  If we make last 5 run reports viewable, what view and format would you like that report in?</p> <p>Of the reminder/recall reports that are currently available, what format would you like?  Decision – have Excel be the format for the report  Decision – have the option to print the report  Decision -- Patient query listing would also be in excel and also printable</p> <p>Patient Comments – should we <b>bold</b> or <b>color</b> patient comments that impact recommendations?  <b>If it could be both, that would be good, but if it's just one, then Color is the decision.</b> It cannot be colored red because that triggers an error message in the CAIR2 system. Yellow would be hard to see. Green is also potentially against the ADI (color green is not seen by people with color/vision issues). Golden yellow can be looked into. Highlighting can be looked into (as long as people don't think they have to click on it if it's highlighted). <b>CDPH will look into colors that are available.</b> As long as we come up with a color with enough contrast, that would be preferred.</p> <p>7229 Past Due Vaccine Recommendations – should we add color coding to past due date in the vaccine recommendations? The fields are already seem to be color coded so the User Group doesn't think this is a big issues to move forward on. Seems to be fine the way it is – no changes, leave as is.</p> <p>7230 Historical Combination Vaccines. Right now, there are no combination vaccines, and there are several steps to add a combination vaccine to populate all of the different antigens CDPH would like to add a not in red regarding only entering the combination vaccine date once and they'd like advice about what the note should say.  Forcing “adding Details First for the vaccines that are combination vaccines” is recommended.</p> <p>When entering a combination vaccine, please enter only one antigen and that date and then click “add details” when you know the trade name, this will auto populate the remaining dates and antigens</p>

	<p>Add “Unknown” as a Trade Name option at the bottom of the list</p> <p>Go with the Note if anyone is using a combo</p> <p>Please enter combination for one antigen only – “Please enter the date, one antigen only of the combination vaccine, then click on <b>add details</b>”</p> <p>If a trade name is not known, it would be good if “Unknown” was a trade name option (this is often a problem with oral polio when dealing with foreign records)</p> <p>7231: Field Name Change – is quantity on hand clear enough? If not, what should it be changed to? <b>Doses on Hand</b> would be clearer. Quantity doesn’t make it clear between vial or dose. <b>Decision, change to “Doses on Hand”</b> Doses on hand applies to all areas where Quantity currently exists. Dose will also be changed to “Dosage” on Edit Vaccine Inventory Screen</p> <p>7258: CAIR Inventory Checkbox on New Immunizations If there’s no inventory, it doesn’t make sense to have this as an option</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Decision – it’s okay to gray the box out if there is no inventory at all in the system. (It won’t be grayed out if there is at least one dose in your inventory) It’s a bit of a useless option if they don’t have inventory and keeping it can cause confusion. So, yes, it should be grayed out if there’s no inventory.</li> <li>2) If their site has inventory, it should be defaulting to the box being checked. Decision, keep the proposed language on the slide as the pop up message to replace the current message</li> </ol> <p>7785: Increase the font size for the patient current age. People appreciate having the age on the History/Recommend page but there was a suggestion to also have it on Edit Patient screen by one participant. <b>Decision to increase the size of the age.</b></p>
4) 2.5 Release	<p>Reminders about what was fixed: (see slides)</p> <p>Freezing issue when radio button, trade name or manufacturer were selected</p> <p>Updated doses administered report</p> <p>Restricted patient comments for read-only users</p> <p>Added counties based on zip codes (really helped reporting)</p>
