# California Immunization Registry Release Notes

## 1. Introduction

The document communicates the major new features and changes in this release of the California Immunization Registry.

## 2. About This Release

This release correct some defects discovered during the Phase 1 and Phase 2 rollouts of the California Immunization Registry software.

## 3. Compatible Products

This product has been tested on the following platforms or with the following products:  
CAIR UAT, CAIR Production

## 4. Bug Fixes

The following fixes appear in this release:

1. Data Exchange (DX)
  - a. Data Exchange email addresses are now populating in CAIR2
  - b. On the Manage Data Exchange module fixed issue where the Testing/Production switch was not working. The switch is now working as expected
  - c. Fixed issue where bi-directional requests were returning information for patients whose data should not have been shared. Requests will now only receive responses for patients who allow sharing.
  - d. Fixed the ability for the DX Technical Staff role so they can use the Save feature on the Manage Data Exchange page.
2. Inventory
  - a. Fixed issue where the inventory transaction types listed under Show Transactions and Reason types under Modify Quantity did not match. The transaction type and reasons are now the same.
  - b. Trade Name Fluzone Quad ID PF has been added to the system.
  - c. The text in the manage transfer and submit HMO data online help has been changed to read CAIR IIS.
3. Blue Card
  - a. Corrected TB Results on Blue Card so they now show the correct results.
4. Yellow Card
  - a. Yellow Card now shows the Date Next Dose Due.
5. User Roles
  - a. User Interface in Production has been fixed so that when upgrading the user roles, The Portal role will no longer populate as Portal Super User Role. Instead it will update the Portal Role to Portal Default Role
  - b. Added the WIC User Role to the Help Desk drop down box and a role selection for editing users.

## 6. General Changes

- a. Made modification to the system so that when an authorized user with a role where soft access is allowed that the default role be the user role not DX Power User Role
- b. Allow authorized users to edit user screen to search by user name in addition to first and last name.
- c. Org Code and Username no longer case sensitive.
