1. Introduction

The document communicates the major new features and changes in this release of the California Immunization Registry.

2. About This Release

This release incorporates the correction of some minor defects discovered during the CAIR Implementation contract period and minor enhancements to the California Immunization Registry software.

3. Compatible Products

This product has been tested on the following platforms or with the following products:

CAIR UAT, CAIR TRN, CAIR Production

4. Bug Fixes

The following items have been fixed in this release:

1. Historical Shots now displaying under Provider of Information column as Transcribed by (Org Code) on Immunization History Report
2. “:” added after CAIR ID, Page Break corrected in report and Eligibility removed from Immunization History Report
3. No longer receiving pop-up Error message for patient address Start Date when no changes are made to the patient record
4. All trivalent flu vaccines removed from Add inventory
5. Ad-Hoc reports, Email address added to selection of “What items would you like to display on the report?”
6. Doses given from recommended, graying out input options From CAIR Inventory button, no longer grayed out
7. Check Status default changed to 1 Day
8. Add Vaccine MenQuadfi CVX Code 203 to Inventory
9. Update Tradename “Unknown” posted by CVX & CPT codes to correct Vaccine

5. New Features

The following new features appear in this release:

- 1. Adding COVID19 vaccines to the Add Vaccine Inventory Information screen**
 1. Created new Trade Names AstraZeneca COVID-19 Vaccine and Janssen (J&J) COVID-19 Vaccine
 2. For both new vaccines all Funding Sources are available.
- 2. Updated ACIP schedule with COVID-19 vaccines**
 1. AstraZeneca added to schedule as a 2 dose schedule.
 2. Janssen (J&J) added to schedule as 1 dose schedule.
 3. Date of first vaccine 18 years old which is the earliest the vaccine can be given.
 4. Second dose for AstraZeneca is 28 days apart.

3. **Global Transport Org (Checkbox added to UI and backend code so checked org can send globally)**
4. **Vital Records/Birth loads**
 1. Add race/ethnicity to vital records data load
 2. Update Birth Load address to populate the patient address
5. **Internal admin updates**
 1. Capture server and port on DX (Data Exchange)
 2. HAPI (HL7 Application Program Interface) update added
